USYCA Executive Team is pleased to announce some key constitutional amendments. The USYCA Constitution was reviewed at the December 2016 Executive Board Meeting. In the Jan 2017 Executive Board Meeting, the USYCA Executive Team jointly discussed all the proposals to the USYCA Constitution.

On Feb 27th 2016, at the USYCA AGM, to which all USYCA Members and Patrons were invited, USYCA Secretary Mr. Ashok Dubey presented all the proposed amendments. These amendments were discussed, voted on and made Final.

Article 1- Section 3 (i): USYCA Governance to be always in compliance and in alignment with the official National Governing Body and the ICC Americas.

Article IX: Add Section 4: The President, Vice Presidents and Secretary of USYCA cannot accept a position at NGB or equivalent cricket organizations while holding an active position on USYCA Board of Directors.

Article IX: Add Section 5: An individual can serve as President for a maximum of 2 consecutive terms (6 years) only. An individual can serve on Board of Directors for a maximum of 3 consecutive terms (9 years).

If any of the above condition is met, an individual must stay out of the governance structure for 1 term (3 years) before accepting a position again on USYCA Board of Directors.

Article III Add Section 17: Full Membership Dues due on March 1st (not March 31st) every year.

USYCA wishes to continue its focus on USA Youth Cricket Development and is committed on keeping its constitution and initiatives aligned in that direction. It once again thanks everyone in USA Cricket community for their support.
