The current term (2016-2019) for the USYCA Executive Team ends April 30th 2019. Since its inception in 2010, USYCA has continued to be a leader in Youth Cricket Development in United States.

USYCA has put more than 2500 Cricket sets in school in last 9 years, and it has been a major contributor towards thousands of school kids and PE Teachers get exposure to cricket.

USYCA has stayed focused and committed to ‘Youth Cricket’ and its merger with NYCL (National Youth Cricket League) in January 2017 has helped create more opportunities in that direction. NYCL has grown from 18 Teams in its first edition in 2014 to 65 Teams in the upcoming NYCL Championship to be held in North Carolina June 26 – July 7 2019 hosted by Triangle Cricket League. The success and growth has purely been due to commitment and hard work of selfless, sincere and dedicated volunteer non paid youth Leaders, without whose support this journey would have been impossible to make.

In 2018, USYCA launched NYCL Girls, a dedicated program to promote Junior Girl Cricket Development across country, with support of some outstanding youth leaders, is gaining momentum quickly.

USA Cricket has been through political turmoil between 2014 and 2019, with rise of American Cricket Federation first (that USYCA was a youth partner with), then the combined effort from various leaderships leading to expulsion of USACA (the NGB of USA Cricket since 1965) in 2017, New Constitution and establishment of New Governance Board under name of ‘USA Cricket’ in 2018. Along the journey we saw Townhall Meetings, Cricket Combines happening all across the country. We saw the national team advance from Division 4 to Division 2. We also

saw significant milestones reached for National U19 Youth and Women's cricket. ICC Americas has done a tremendous job of managing the day to day cricket affairs in USA from late 2015 till Date, and continues to firmly lead the cricket management today and possibly for many years to come until USA is among the top Cricketing Nations in the Country.

USYCA continues to provide Free Cricket Sets to Schools. It continues to connect the youth programs across the country and it continues to create more opportunities for Junior Players across the country. It aspires to someday be able to work closely with National Governing Body of USA in establishing a strong domestic structure for Youth Cricket.

USYCA is not an individual. There have been some outstanding people who have led USYCA in past. I lead USA today with support of some excellent youth leaders. And it will continue to grow in future the same way. I hope to see USA Cricket to, someday, have leaders at top level, that empower and motivate their subordinates. A leadership that will install a new love and passion for the sport of cricket in one and all.

To take USYCA forward, we need some outstanding leaders. And 2019 Elections is a great time to nominate yourself or someone you know, who fits the working principles and mission of USYCA.
